

The Southwest Police Motorcycle Training and Competition falls under the Law Enforcement Torch Run® (LETR). This is the largest public awareness vehicle and grassroots fundraiser for Special Olympics. Known honorably as Guardians of the Flame, nearly 110,000 law enforcement personnel and Special Olympics athletes annually carry the "Flame of Hope," symbolizing courage and a celebration of diversity that unites communities around the globe. In addition, law enforcement supporters host fundraisers throughout the year and have raised more than \$600 million for Special Olympics.

### WHAT WE DO

The Southwest Police Motorcycle Training Competition is an annual event that is hosted by Motorcycle Officers of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Pima County Sheriff's Department, and Phoenix Police Department. Every year, one agency will take its turn to host the event where 100% of their proceeds are donated to support their local Special Olympics.

### WHY WE DO IT

Special Olympics Nevada provides free athletic training and competition to individuals with developmental disabilities, and allows them the chance to demonstrate to the world all they are capable of achieving. Our goal is to raise a minimum of \$20,000.00 so we can help enhance the quality of life of our community's Special Olympic Athletes.
